ABOUT

Undergraduate Plummer Scholars Program (UPS) is a distance learning program. The primary aim of UPS is to expose, excite, and engage underrepresented undergraduate students with high potential of pursuing a career in medicine. Webinars are conducted via Zoom; Webinars are held on Saturday mornings at 10am CT every other month.

The Undergraduate Plummer Scholars Plus (UPS+) is a distinct track within the larger UPS program specifically for outstanding students with a GPA of at least 3.2 and plans to take the MCAT in the next 12-months. Academic Year UPS students can apply for admission to an intensive week-long UPS+ Summer Program in June and July 2025 between one of our three campuses in AZ, MN, or FL. Students accepted into the summer program will also participate in near-peer mentorship with Mayo Clinic Alix School of Medicine medical students. Completion of the UPS Academic Year Program and separate application for UPS+ is required. Summer program applications for eligible students will be available in December 2024.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Pre-medical undergraduate students planning to apply to medical school. Incoming freshmen are not eligible, but we welcome applications as rising sophomores the next year.
